Jeff is co-founder and co-artistic/technical director of Horizon Theatre Company. He has been a partner in creating Horizon's artistic programming since 1983. He has directed over 25 plays for Horizon including critically acclaimed productions of *Charm School* by Larry Larson and Eddie Levi Lee, *Permanent Collection* by Thomas Gibbons, *The Drawer Boy* by Michael Healey, *Madame Melville* by Richard Nelson, *The Lonesome West* by Martin McDonough, *Racing Demon* by David Hare, *All in the Timing* and *Mere Mortals* by David Ives and *The Joy of Going Somewhere Definite* by Quincy Long. He leads the Horizon Senior Citizens Ensemble, founded in 1995, an outreach program that trains seniors in acting and playwriting and tours plays by and about seniors to locations throughout Atlanta. In addition to his artistic duties, he also directs Horizon's technical and production staff and manages the facility. He studied at the Goodman School of Drama and holds a BA in Theatre from Roosevelt University.
